VIPER WINCH MOUNT MA11817 Honda Pioneer 500

- Be observant of moving parts causing entanglement, use extreme caution!



- 1) If your kit includes an optional rubber line stopper, install that first by removing the cable from the winch. Run the cable through the line stopper and then through the fairlead (Roller or Aluminum depending on winch kit) and then through the fairlead opening at the front of the Pioneer winch mount. Reattach the cable to the winch drum. You can see instructional video on this process here: http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=AXWQTkJm7Yo.
- 2) Remove the front bumper using an M12 socket to remove the upper two bolts and an M14 socket to remove the lower two bolts as shown in Figure 1.

3) Hold the Main Winch Bracket up to the two vertical tubes that connect to the radiator support. Using the 5/16" U-bolts, loosely secure the winch mount to the vertical tubes. NOTE: the SHORTER U-bolt should be installed in the upper-right Ubolt holes.



4) With the mount plate loosely attached to the vertical tubes, move the mount plate upward so that the top of the plate is inline with the sideways 'U' channels that hold the bumper. See Figure 2 & 3. When aligned, tighten the 5/16" Nuts.





5) Install the winch with the motor end on the Passenger Side of the vehicle.



- 6) Reinstall the front bumper in reverse order, verify that the top of the winch plate is touching or close to touching the square tubing on the bumper.
- 7) Install the Winch Support Brackets over the square bumper tubing. Use the 1/4" Hardware to secure the brackets to the winch mount plate. See Winch Mount Assembly View and Figure 4.

Electrical Setup

Before working on your vehicles electrical system, disconnect the negative battery terminal and secure it away from the battery.

- 8) Remove each of the plastic underbody panels to allow for wire routing.
- 9) Although the winch contactor is built to withstand the harshest offroad conditions we recommend mounting the contactor in a 'high and dry' location. Figure 5 shows the contactor mounted to the side plastic within the front storage compartment. Connect the toggle switch or optional dash switch to the contactor terminals and connect the red wire to an auxiliary power source, we use the positive wire that feeds the cigarette lighter.





- 10) When installing a Viper winch, it is necessary to switch the longer Blue/Yellow cables with the shorter Black/Red cables to reach the battery terminals.
- 11) Connect the Black cable to the Blue post on the winch and the Red cable to the Yellow post on the winch. Run these cables up to the front storage compartment and connect the Black cable to the Blue post on the contactor and the Red cable to the Yellow post on contactor.
- 12) Connect the Yellow cable to the Red Post on the contactor and the Blue Cable to the Black post on the contactor. Route the cables to the drive shaft tunnel and run the

cables toward the battery compartment. With the Negative battery terminal disconnected and secured away from the battery, mount the Yellow cable to the Positive post on the Starter Solenoid as shown in Figure 6 & Figure 7.



13) Reconnect the negative battery terminal and connect the blue cable as shown in Figure 7. Verify that the winch feeds in and out in the correct directions.
